"Sower, Seed, and Praise." April 30, 2023

<sup>"10</sup> He who supplies seed to the sower and bread for food will supply and multiply your seed for sowing and increase the harvest of your righteousness. <sup>11</sup> You will be enriched in every way to be generous in every way, which through us will produce thanksgiving to God." **II Corinthians 9:10-15** 

- **1. 2 Corinthians 9:11 says that generosity produces "thanksgiving to God."** Can you think of a time when someone's generosity led you to praise God?
- 2. Greg said, "Sin is a lonely business. Sin leads us away from relationship to God and others." Have you experienced the loneliness of greed? How does that compare with experiences of generosity?
- 3. Greg said that the American Evangelical church tends to be deeply concerned with hotbutton topics like sexuality. He then said, "The false god of sexuality is not a bigger false God than money." Does Greg's statement align with the amount of concern you experience about the topic of money? Or that you see expressed in Christian community? Why or why not?
- 4. When we glorify ourselves, we are arrogant. When God glorifies Himself, He is worthy of glory. Think about your day-to-day life. In what ways are you tempted to glorify yourself?

We often talk about taking your next step of faith with Jesus. As you reflect on this week's teaching, what is the next step of faith you'll commit to?
