“The King is Coming” October 30th, 2022

“Say to the daughter of Zion,
Behold, your king is coming to you,
humble, and mounted on a donkey,
on a colt, the foal of a beast of burden.”

Matthew 21:1-11

- 1. Oftentimes, we think God will ask us to do extraordinary things for Him. Yet, Jesus regularly uses the ordinary realities of our lives to build His kingdom.** What ordinary parts of your life is God using for His purposes?
- 2. Throughout the gospels, we see Jesus being humble and kind in how He offers His kingdom. He comes as a meek Savior.** What does that reality mean to you?
- 3. JC talked about reaching the end of our efforts– perhaps we have unmet longings, sin, and disappointment.** We want to give up, but then we hear, “the King is coming.” In what places do you need to hear that hopeful message?
- 4. Jesus is King, and He is constantly entering into the areas where we have not made Him King.** As you hear those words, does anything boil to the surface of your heart?

We often talk about taking your next step of faith with Jesus. As you reflect on this week's teaching, what is the next step of faith you'll commit to?
