Samuel 1 and 2

- 1. Rick said that as we walk through winter seasons, we must remember that spring is coming. Similarly in our spiritual lives, we wait for the Spring of Jesus' return. As you reflect on your current season, what areas of your life do you long for Jesus to restore?
- 2. Read Psalm 39 verse 4 and 5. In these verses, David describes life as "fleeting." Does your life reflect that reality? If not, how might you grow to use your time wisely?
- 3. 1 Samuel 15:19 describes Saul as being "small in his own eyes." Rick described the insecurity and self-obsession we all experience because of our need to gain personal glory. Do you relate to that? In what ways?
- 4. Scripture tells us that God looks at the heart rather than the outward appearance. In the battle for hope, we must be a people that continually turn to Him. What daily rhythms or practices help you cultivate true hope in Him?

We often talk about taking your next step of faith with Jesus. As you reflect on this week's teaching, what is the next step of faith you'll commit to?
