KEY REFERENCE	
After six days Jesus took with him Peter, James and John the brother of James, and led them up a high mountain by themselves. There he was transfigured before them. -Matthew 17:1-3	
Six days after Peter correctly identified Jesus as the Messiah, the Son of the living God (Mat. 16:16), Jesus gives three of his disciples a glimpse of his divine glory.	
For when Jesus is transfigured, he is described with language that was used in the Old Testament to describe God's appearance (Dan. 7:9). As God affirms Jesus' identity, the disciples see divine confirmation that Jesus is the Messigh
