Aiming to Please

for the week of January 17, 2020

1. Discuss the difference between being a people-pleaser and "not looking to your own interests but each of you to the interests of others." (Philippians 2:4)

Who we try to please drastically affects how we live out our daily lives. This week we'll learn who Jesus focused on pleasing. *Read Luke 4:14-23.*

- 2. We see that Jesus was praised by everyone during his early ministry (v15). What are the dangers of finding our sense of worth from the praise of others?
- 3. In verses 18-21 Jesus reads from Isaiah. What does this passage have to teach us about Jesus' mission?
- 4. How do the people respond to Jesus' declaration? Consider both their verbal response as well as what Jesus knows of their thoughts.
- 5. What do you think Jesus might have said after this if he were concerned with keeping his audience happy? What concessions might he have made?

Read Luke 4:24-30

- 6. Why does Jesus use the examples of Elijah and Elisha in addressing the people?
- 7. What is their response to his teaching? Why do you think you they have a mind to kill Jesus at this point?
- 8. Why was Jesus able to stay focused on honoring God even when it meant upsetting people?
- 9. Is there something you feel called to that will please God, even though it might anger/frustrate/let down somebody else? What might you miss out on if you choose to please people?
- 10. How can the group pray for you in that situation?
