Make a Difference

for the week of September 22, 2019

1. Talk about a time somebody unexpectedly chose to serve you or met a need in your life.

We could sit and think of countless ways to make a difference in the lives of others – but it's a gamechanger when we actually get out of our seats and start taking action to meet the needs of those around us. This week we'll look at two people who made a difference because God had made them different. Read Acts 9:32-42

- 2. Was Peter invited to visit Lydda (verse 32)? Did Aeneas ask Peter to heal him (verses 33-34)? If nobody asked for his help, why did Peter do these things?
- 3. Should we always wait to be asked for help? Should we never wait to be asked for help? Is there a middle ground? Explain why.
- 4. Re-read verses 36-39. What was Tabitha's reputation amongst the people in Joppa? What affect did her death have on the people there?
- 5. Do you believe that Tabitha was going to be missed? Why or why not?
- 6. Is the church making the kind of difference in our community that we would be missed if we were gone? Explain remember that "the church" is God's people, not a building.
- 7. Why do you think Peter made sure to present the resurrected Tabitha to the widows?
- 8. Both Peter and Tabitha made a difference to those around them. Did one of them have a greater impact than the other? Do we have to do the miraculous in order to make a difference?
- 9. God may have a miraculous appointment for you someday. In the meantime, how can you made a difference like Tabitha in your community?
