1. Can you think of a time when you tried to do something kind for someone and it didn't go as planned?
2. What are some reasons that cause kind actions to go awry or be misinterpreted?
3. In this week's sermon, we talked about getting to know someone new so we can love them generously. When you first heard this idea, what were your thoughts?

Read Romans 13:8-10

4. What do you think about the idea of the debt of love? Is this more or less challenging than following the commandments speaks of?
5. What would life look like if the debt of love weighed as heavily on us as financial debt?
6. Why is financial debt felt often felt to a greater degree than the debt of love?

Read Matthew 11:28-30

7. What does it mean to take on the yoke of Jesus?
8. Why would Jesus describe his yoke as easy and his burden light?
9. In the sermon, it was encouraged to put together a plan of who you can get to know and how you might go about it. As a group, share who you're going to get to know and how you're going to go about it. (If there are group members that haven't put this plan together, take some time as a group to help them get this together).
