- I. Paul served everyone possible (vv. 19-23).
 - A. Service requires us to surrender our rights (v. 19).
 - Paul gave up his right to financial support from the church (v. 19a).
 - 2. Serving Christ requires that we surrender our entitlements (Jn. 12:24-26).
 - B. Service aims to win more (v. 19b).
 - 1. Paul's objective was to win more (v. 19b).
 - 2. God wants us to play for all the marbles (Jn. 3:16; Matt. 18:10-14)!
 - C. Service means catering to the preferences and desires of the people we want to reach (vv. 20-23).
 - 1. Paul catered to Jews (v. 20a).
 - 2. Paul catered to Legalists (v. 20b).
 - 3. Paul catered to Gentiles (v. 21).
 - 4. Paul catered to the Weak (v. 22a).
 - 5. Paul catered in every possible way (v. 22b-23).
 - a. Paul desired to save as many people as possible (v. 22b).
 - b. Paul desired to share in the greatest blessing possible (v. 23).
 - 6. God wants us to cater to the preferences and desires of others (Phil. 2:4).

 - A. By giving up our entitlements.
 - B. By dreaming for more.
 - C. By catering to the preferences and desires of those who are not here yet.
