What to Do When Crisis Crushes You Ruth 1

- I. We will inevitably face crises in our life that will crush us (vv. 1-5).
 - A. Naomi experienced crushing loss in her life (vv. 1-5).
 - B. Crises are part of life in a broken world (Jn. 16:33).
- II. God's tender compassion is at work during our terrible crisis (vv. 6-22).
 - A. When Naomi grieved and God seemed invisible there were still traces of his love (vv. 6-22).
 - 1. God visited Bethlehem (v. 6).
 - 2. God gave Naomi company in her misery (vv. 7-21).
 - 3. God starts to unveil his tender grace (v. 22).
 - B. When we hurt, God hurts with us and his compassion is at work for us (Jn. 11:28-37).
- III. Grieve your losses (and let God redeem).
 - A. Don't worry about having heroic faith, which is God's job to cultivate as he unveils his redemption in the midst of your loss.
 - B. There are always visible traces of God's love in our greatest crisis.
 - C. God is at work for the good during the darkest of times of his people.
 - D. God ultimately purposes for our happiness, glory and good when all is said and done.
