- Grip
- Flow

- Unior
- A working relationship (answered prayer and obedience)
- God's promises
- Holy Spirit (Gal 5:22, Eph 5:18, 2Cor 3:17)
- Exchanged life (Gal 2:20, Eph 2:6)

Taking the time to grow. Exo 23:29 No occasion not to abide

Dangers when insisting on the outcomes of abiding

Living with being granted all things that pertain to life and godliness (2 Peter 1:3-8)
