The Church That Wins

A Guide to Ministry Success During Turbulent Times Hebrews 10:32-39

- I. Remember the cause that fueled your past success (vv. 32-34).
 - A. Success has been achieved during times when stakes are high (vv. 32-33).
 - B. Success has been achieved with noble attitudes (v. 34a).
 - C. Success was driven by a greater purpose (v. 34b).
- II. Recommit to your why (vv. 35-39).
 - A. Our past purpose remains our present cause (v. 35).
 - B. Our present cause still requires costly sacrifice (vv. 36-39).
 - 1. We pay the cost for the sake of the prize (v. 36).
 - 2. We pay the cost because we are accountable (vv. 37-38).
 - a. Jesus will be here soon (v. 37)...
 - b. Winners remember to keep their eyes on the prize (v. 38a).
 - c. Losers who give up the race give up God's favor (v. 38b).
 - d. We are not losers who quit but winners who persevere and receive the reward (v. 39)!
- III. The church that is driven by God's purpose is the church that will obtain God's reward (Rev. 3:7-13).
- IV. Conclusion: Recommit to your why.
 - A. Be driven by Kingdom purpose and not pet projects.
 - B. Commit to the Kingdom cause and not to circumstantial strategy.
 - C. Revisit and recommit to this plan often.
