## Being the New You (Part 2)

Who We Must Walk Away From and Who We Must Walk Toward Ephesians 4:17-24

- 1. Living out our new identity is a daily decision (vv. 20-24).
  - A. We must choose daily to leave our old identity in the past (v. 20).
  - B. We must choose daily to live out our new identity in Christ (vv. 21-24).
    - 1. We choose the new because of what we know about Jesus (vv. 21; Cf. Jn 4:10).
    - 2. When we know Jesus we abandon our old self (v. 22; Cf. 2 Cor. 5:17).
    - 3. When we know Jesus we make a daily decision to think differently about life (v. 23; 2 Cor. 10:5).
    - 4. When we know Jesus we make a daily decision to live differently (v. 24; Cf. Rom 8:5-6).
- II. Spiritual transformation is a result of receiving God's grace through Jesus Christ (Jn. 3:1-15).
  - A. Jesus calls us to be born again (vv. 1-8).
  - B. Rebirth comes by faith in the resurrected Christ (vv. 9-15).
- III. Take steps toward becoming who Jesus says you are and who he created you to be.
  - A. Leave behind the old you.
  - B. Commit to regularly receiving God's grace.
  - C. Commit to regularly forgiving yourself and others.
  - D. Commit to restarting.
