Theme: The last "I AM" Jesus spoke clarified that His resurrection restores us & all creation.

I Myself, not a Spirit (Lk. 24:36-39)

- After events on the road to Emmaus He himself stood in their midst: 'Peace!'
- Startled & frightened, they thought they were seeing a spirit.
- 'Why are you troubled? Doubt?' 'See, it is I Myself' [Lit. 'Myself, I AM']
 - 'Touch me & see; a spirit doesn't have flesh & bones'



- This continuity is critical. If Jesus wasn't raised physically redemption wasn't accomplished.
 - Bavinck: "It is God's honor that He redeems & renews the same humanity, world, heaven & earth that was corrupted & polluted by sin."
- Creation is counting on continuity
 - Rom. 8:9-14;19-23 There is a link between what happens to us and to the whole creation.
 - Not a strand of DNA escapes the fall or redemption. Every planet & star is affected
- Psalm 90:17 "Establish the work of our hands."
 - "Every Kingdom work ... will find its place in the heavenly order." B. Milne
 - "Our error has not been in over- estimating the extent of God's redemption, but in under estimating it."

"Dwelling of God is with men!" (Rev. 21)

The 'heaven' we go to when we die is the intermediate heaven. It is perfect, but not the final heaven. The 'new heaven', 'new earth' & 'new Jerusalem' is described in Rev. 21

"All things new" (Rev.21,22)

- It will come down out of heaven (21:2)
- He will dwell with us. We will be His people. God will be our God. (3)
- He'll give water of life to overcomers (6)
- There'll be no Temple in the city
- The glory of God gives it light
- The nations will bring their glory
- Those whose names are in the Lamb's book of life will be there.
- We will experience ... (22:1ff.)
 - Water of Life
 - Tree of Life
 - Healing of nations
 - Seeing His face, have his name on forehead
 - Reigning forever & ever

Applications (22:12,17)

- Jesus: "Behold, I am coming soon."
- "The Spirit & Bride say: 'Come'"
- "Let the thirsty come"
- So, let's go, living like the resurrection really happened!
