Getting to Know Me Questions:

- What is your ideal thermostat temperature during the winter?
- Do you prefer hot or cold drinks? What is your drink of choice?

Into the Bible Questions:

- What's something from the teaching that you learned, stood out, interesting, etc.
- Think of someone with "hot" faith. What sets them apart in your mind?
- Today's theme is '**I believe in God, but I don't want to be one of those people who take it too far**'.
- How do you react to this idea? Is this something you have been accused of? Have you accused others doing this?
- **READ:** Revelations 3:15-20
- In this letter of Revelation to the Church,
- Pastor Kirby gave 6 ways we tend to be lukewarm Christians
 1. A lukewarm Christian craves acceptance from people more than from God
 2. A lukewarm Christian rarely shares their faith in Jesus
 3. A lukewarm Christian rationalizes their sin
 4. A lukewarm Christian prioritizes the things of earth over the Kingdom of Heaven
 5. A lukewarm Christian only turns to God when they need something.
 6. A lukewarm Christian is not that much different than anyone else
- Do you agree/disagree with the list? What would you add or remove?
- Which of these do you relate to most?
- READ/RESPOND to the following verses. What does it say about a life of following Jesus?
- 1 Timothy 6:11-12; 1 John 2:6; 1 Corinthians 9:24-27; Galatians 5:13-16

Application Questions:

- Share some areas of your life where you need Jesus to bring the heat? Sin, generosity, boldness, trust, closeness, faith
- Write down one lukewarm area of your faith to tackle this week. If it's generosity, try giving more time and resources away. If it's sharing your faith, share Jesus with one person, and so on.
