Into the Bible Questions:

- What's something from this week's teaching that you learned, stood out, was interesting?
- What is something you have done that takes a lot of commitment? What did that commitment look like?
- How would you define commitment?
- What does commitment to God look like?
- Read Nehemiah 8:1-3; 6
- In chapter 9 we read about how the Israelites responded through confession.
- Why was confession a response to the worship in Nehemiah 8?
- How do you see a connection between confession and worship in your life and in faith?
- The Israelites followed their confession with a renewed commitment to God. There was an order to these events. Worship leads to confessions which leads to commitment. How or why is this significant?
- READ: Galatians 2:20
- What do we learn about commitment from this verse?
- What do you think it means that our "old self has been crucified with Christ"?
- Who is someone you know that is good at listening to God? What can you learn from them?
- Why can it be hard to commit to obey God?
- What is one way that you can obey God this week?
