Getting to Know Me Questions:

- Fall is here. What is your favorite thing about this season?
- When was the last time you lost something that really drove you nuts as you desperately searched for it? Did you ever find it?

Into the Bible Questions:

- What's something from this week's teaching that you learned, that stood out, interesting etc?
- In our lives, weird is often defined as things we don't understand. However leaning into the "weird" can often help us understand more about life in general, and for our purposes, more about faith and how God interacts with us.
- When something or someone or an idea is weird to you, what's your first response (be honest) 😊
- **Read: 2 Kings 6:1-7**
- As you read/hear this story, what are some of the weird things happening?
- A Spiritual Edge is loosely defined as 'a passion, love, intention and ability in all areas of our spiritual life.'
- **3 parts to getting our edge back:**
- **1) Cry out to God.**
- When you think about this idea, what goes through your mind? Are you able to cry out to God? If so, how?
- Where are you tired, worn out, out of passion or out of options?
- **2) Be honest about where you lost it.**
- Speak about something in your life that you would identify as losing your "spiritual edge". Is there a certain event or chain of events that have happened?
- Do you find it difficult to be honest with God about your frustrations and fears etc?
- **READ: Proverbs 27:17**
- Do you have someone in your life to help you with your spiritual edge?
- **3) With God's help, take back what you lost.**
- What area of your life have you identified as a place where you want to get your edge back?
- What step of obedience have you done or do you need to do in order for that to happen?
- Meditate on this prayer of Jesus for us. What do you feel and think about this prayer?

Application Questions:

- What steps will you attempt this week to sharpen that edge?
- Use those in this group and/or other trusted people, to follow up with you about how it's going.
- Pray and support each other as you pursue this!
