I. Why do we fail to see God clearly? (vv.9-13)

A. Rebellion (vv.9-10) Isaiah 1:19-20; Isaiah 65:2

SIN = Willful disobedience to the known will of God.

James 4:17

B. They put God in their box (vv.8-10) II Kings 5:9-15;

Romans 11:33-34; II Corinthians 3:5; Mark 10:27

C. We see God through ourselves (v.10) I Corinthians 12:11-12

1. We aren't balanced I Corinthians 12:11-12

2. We are right and everyone else is wrong -

I Corinthians 12:24-27

D. We see God through our parent's (v.10)

Deuteronomy 6:5-9

E. We see God through the media or world - 1 John 2:15-17;

James 11:6

F. We don't see God because of apathy - Hebrews 11:38;

Hebrews 11:6; II Timothy 2:15; Psalm 42:1-2

II. What happens when we see God clearly (vv. 1-8)

A. Confession of crisis brings us to God (v.1)

C. Change (vv.6-7) Psalm 40:1-3; II Corinthians 5:17;

Jeremiah 29:11

D. Commitment (vv.8-9) Proverbs 23:26; Romans 12:1-2;

Galatians 2:20
