- 2. The Name Jonah means <u>Dove</u> II Kings 14:25; Ephesians 6:20
- 3. The Key <u>Characters</u> in this Book are God and Jonah Jonah 1:1-2; 3:2; 1:4; 1:17; 2:10; 3:10; 4:6-8
- 4. There are Six Significant Subjects in the Book of Jonah
 - A. Sets forth the Resurrection Matthew 12:40
 - B. Teaches Salvation by Grace not Works -Jonah 2:9
 - C. God's Purpose of Grace Can't be stopped- Jonah 1:2
 - D. God will not cast us aside for <u>Faithlessness</u> Jonah 1:3; Hebrews 11:6; II Corinthians 5:7
 - E. God is <u>Good</u> and <u>Gracious</u> Jonah 4:2; Lamentations 3:22-23
 - F. God is also the God of the Gentiles -Jonah 1:2; Galatians 3:28
- 5. Key Lessons in the Book of Jonah
 - A. God's Call is Man's Opportunity Isaiah 6:8
 - B. Man's <u>Surrender</u> is <u>God's Opportunity</u> -Romans 12: 1-2
 - C. There is <u>Danger</u> in <u>Running</u> from God- Hebrews 12:6; Revelations 2:19
 - D. There is to be no <u>Detour</u> in the Path of Christian Service- I Corinthians 15:58
 - E. <u>Pride</u> will keep one from <u>Winning</u> Souls-Proverbs 13:10
 - F. If We judge ourselves, God will Chasten us I Corinthians 11:31; Psalms 139:23-24
 - G. When We Backslide or Run From God, We need to Go Back Where We Got off Track or Disobeyed the Lord- Jeremiah 3:22
