Today is not because of coincidence but is in fact a result of Consequence.

You are hear by divine appointment for divine purpose and you exist to fulfill the will of the Father of Lights in whom there is no darkness at all.

May you see your reflection and not lose the details forgetting what you saw and meandering through life without purpose.

May you be quickened at the revelation of His Truth and His Son Jesus as He stands at the door of your life waiting for total access.

Do not be weary in well doing for in due season you will reap a harvest of blessing.

This Act will cause you to have due seasons. Due seasons are kairos moments where harvest is ready because of your sowing. Whether you sow to the flesh corrupt seeds or sow fro and to the spirit.

Sowing means you reap

Reaping takes place in kairos moments not on the four seasons calendar or specific time of the year or when everyone else is preparing for harvest.

Sowing activates opportunity. Opportunity is kairos. Kairos is time that shows up as an insert into your timeline. It's an interruption.

When the parent sowed to the Spirit we see

the offspring doing the same thing.

Sow "what"

There are no limits to sowing and reaping except what you place on them.

You can sow good or bad and that is exactly what you will see later

You can sow good seed or bad seed - product Sow to the Spirit or Sow to the flesh - placement

Sowing activates a law of reaping and sowing - process

You have a widow woman and her son. They have oil and flour and Elijah

Elijah and the Widow at Zarephath

7 Some time later the brook dried up because there had been no rain in the land. 8

Then the word of the Lord came to him: 9 "Go at once to Zarephath in the region of Sidon and stay there. I have directed a widow there to supply you with food." 10 So he went to Zarephath. When he came to the town gate, a widow was there gathering sticks. He called to her and asked, "Would you bring me a little water in a jar so I may have a drink?" 11 As she was going to get it, he called, "And bring me, please, a piece of bread."

12 "As surely as the Lord your God lives," she replied, "I don't have any bread—only a handful of flour in a jar and a little olive oil in a jug. I am gathering a few sticks to take home and make a meal for myself and my son, that we may eat it—and die."

13 Elijah said to her, "Don't be afraid. Go home and do as you have said. But first make a small loaf of bread for me from what you have and bring it to me, and then make something for yourself and your son. 14 For this is what the Lord, the God of Israel, says: 'The jar of flour will not be used up and the jug of oil will not run dry until the day the Lord sends rain on the land."

15 She went away and did as Elijah had told her. So there was food every day for Elijah and for the woman and her family. 16 For the jar of flour was not used up and the jug of oil did not run dry, in keeping with the word of the Lord spoken by Elijah

The widow sowed oil and flour and reaped oil and flour.

The widow sowed to the prophet. This is the ground where process was ignited.

She could have eaten it herself with her son and reaped from the flesh only. Because in times of trouble you must know where and what to sow. You can't sow to the flesh and expect a heavenly response of harvest. You must sow to the spirit by doing a spiritual act of the Spirit to see a response in accordance with the law of God.
