

" "t service were held this for two women evangelists o were killed last week in a trafaccident on the Detroit-Toledo Expressway a mile south of Monroe, Michigan,

The victims were Mrs. Addie B. Smith, 38, of 852 Hamilton St., and Mrs. Maggie Johnson, 33, of 1328 Bronson Ave .. both evangelists at Pinewood Faith Tabernacle. 535 Pinewood Ave.

The two women and three other occupants of the car in which they were riding were en route to the International Gospel Center, Ecorse, Michigan for a bible reading class.

Their car skidded 225 feet after passing a truck before it struck a cemient bridge railing over La-Plaisance Creek. Both of the women died of crushed chests.
