

1. The Seed

Jesus says, "The sower sows the word" (verse 14).

In Luke 8:11, He says, "Now the parable is this: The seed is the **Word** of **God**"

 "The best chance that I have at understanding what God desires of me."

 Man should not live by bread alone, but by every word that proceeds out of the mouth of God - Matthew 4:4



2. The Birds

 This particular ground was not meant for sowing, but for walking. It was a pathway for walking.(verse 4)

 The soil was not <u>conducive</u> for growing crops



2. The Birds

What is particularly interesting about this text is the mentioning of the enemy with three different names in the three Gospel versions of this parable.

The evil one – Matthew 13:19

<u>Satan</u> – Mark 4:15

The devil - Luke 8:12

Jesus personalized the work of Satan (not his demons, and not the flesh)



3. The Stony Ground

- Not much soil; there is quick growth because of a lack of depth
- Temporary proskairos to last for a <u>season</u> or a little while
- Lacking <u>consistency</u> and <u>discipline</u>



3. The Stony Ground

- The Sun:
 - Persecution or affliction because of the Word
- Every believer will have to deal with the sun.
- Your roots need to be deep, to survive the heat.



4. The Thorny Ground

 The thorns will grow with you...and choke you.

- 3 things that will choke the Word out of the believer:
 - Worry of the World (Ages)
 - Deceitfulness of wealth
 - Worldly Pleasures



4. The Thorny Ground

- The plant will grow...but bear little or no fruit.
- Luke 8:14 "...bring no fruit to maturity."
 - To not come to <u>maturity</u>
 - Fruit that does not <u>ripen</u>
 - Pregnancy with no delivery
 - Religion without righteousness



5. The Good Soil

- How can we describe "good soil"? Soil that is treated and prepared. Good seed need good soil.
 - Soil with <u>purpose</u> and intent for growth
 - Soil with stones and obstructions removed and with plenty of room for growth
 - Soil that has been <u>purged</u> of weeds and briars



5. The Good Soil

- 3 different descriptions of "good" soil:
- Matthew 13:23 "...hears the word and <u>understands</u> it."
 - <u>Understand</u> It all comes together and makes sense.
- Mark 4:20 "...they hear the word and accept it."
 - Accepting receiving or taking for one's self
- Luke 18:15 "...heard the word in an <u>honest</u> and good heart, and <u>hold it fast</u>, and bear fruit with perseverance."
 - Hold fast to possess; to keep secure; to not let it go
