God did not shut His ears to the prayers of Cornelius

God has testified that Jesus is Lord of all

By His people

God has poured out His Spirit even on the Gentiles

1. What is this passage telling me about who God is (His character, actions, attributes, Word)?
2. What actions are being commanded, encouraged, celebrated, prohibited, or warned against?
3. What is the main purpose of this passage, and does it bring other passages to mind?
4. How much of what Peter spoke seems to have been new or expanded revelation not just for Cornelius but for Peter as well?
5. What does this passage help me to see about Jesus or the gospel?

**Do the Word**

1. How do my actions, thoughts, words or emotions need to change in light of this passage?
2. What evidence of God's work in my life do I need to thank and praise Him for?
3. What relationships has God brought to mind that need to change?
4. Do I see any other way that this should impact my worship of God?
