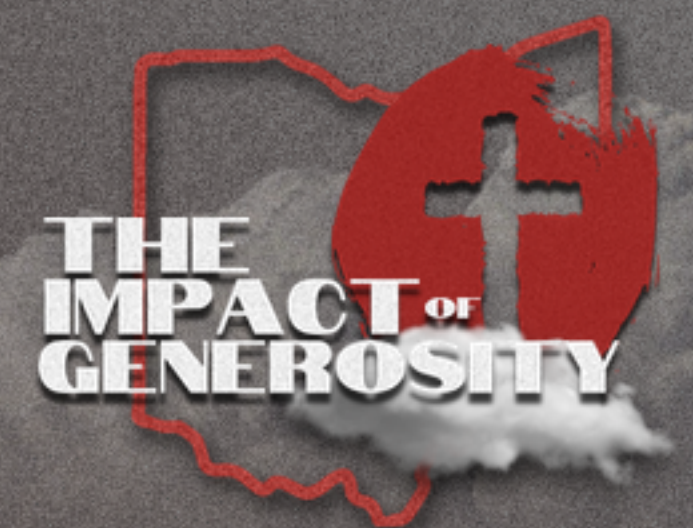
Luke 10:25-26

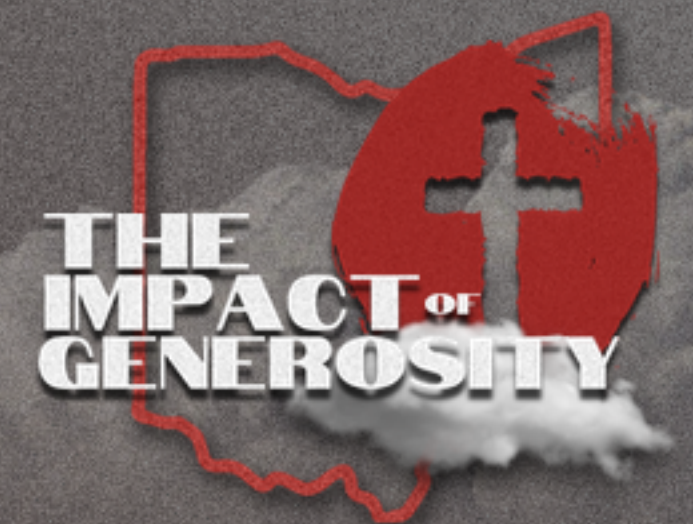
Luke 10:27-29

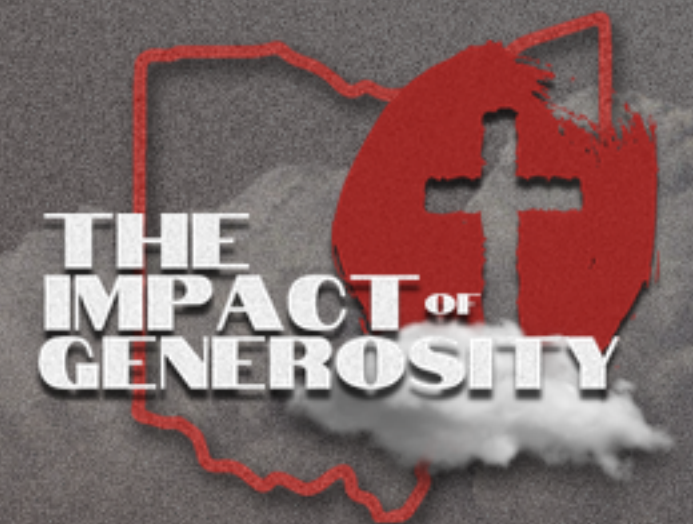
Luke 10:30-32

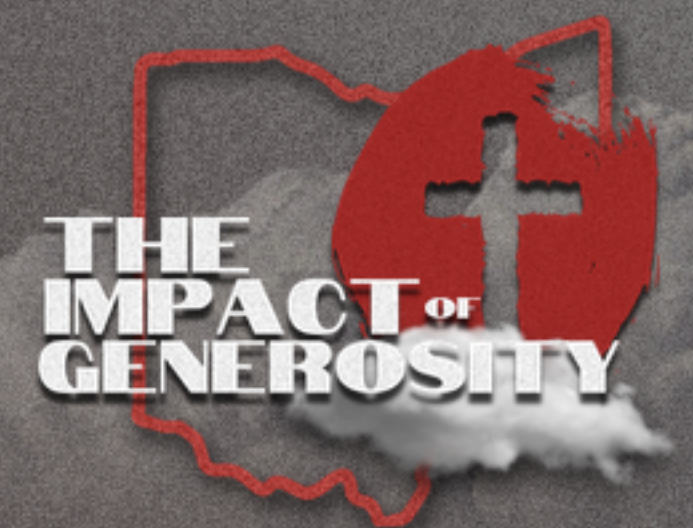
