Ps. 84:1 Isaiah 37:16

1. When you think about being in the “Presence” of God what comes to your mind?
2. What was the purpose of the Tabernacle in the Old Testament? (This was a really large and fancy tent that the Israelites set up at different places as they moved around. God chose to dwell in this physical structure)
3. Describe the “Holy of Holies” area of the Tabernacle. (This area was the area where God’s presence was the strongest. A person was only allowed to enter this area one time each year. The separation between God and man was very clear)
4. In Matthew 27:46-51, the view of the temple is torn in two. What does this mean for us Spiritually? (Jesus has made a way for us to be close to God that was never possible until the sacrifice of Jesus)

5. What is your reflection on these two scriptures in Hebrews?
