- 6. At the end of the story who is the character that is not right with God?
- 7. What is the main point of this parable?
- 8. Kory Martin shared this quote regarding the younger brother: "The addicted life can aptly be described as a life lived in "A distant country." It is there that our cry for deliverance rises up" Henry Nouwen --- How do you relate to the younger brother in this story?
- 9. Kory shared this quote regarding the Older brother: "Elder brother self-righteousness not only creates racism and classism, but at a personal level creates an unforgiving, judgmental spirit." Tim Keller -- How do you relate to the older brother in the story?
- 10. Comment on the Fathers love demonstrated in this story. What does this teach us about God?
