The 3 stages of change in Peter's life: 1. His Conversion 2. His Discipleship 3. His Apostleship



1. His Conversion



One of the two who heard John speak and followed Jesus was Andrew, Simon Peter's brother. 41 He first found his own brother Simon and said to him, "We have found the Messiah" (which means Christ). 42 He brought him to Jesus looked at him and said, "You are Simon the son of John. You shall be called Cephas" (which means Peter).

2. His Discipleship



Being confident of this very thing, that he which hath begun a good work in you will perform it until the day of Jesus Christ:
