1. What are your reflections on the message from Pastor Jim?
2. Just thinking off the top of your head, what is best application to your life from this message?

Acts 3:1-11

3. How long had beggar in this story been crippled?
4. How do you think you would feel to have a handicap like that all of your life?
5. Verse 11 of Acts 3 says that the Beggar “Held on” to Peter and John. Share some reasons why the beggar would want to “Hold on” to them.
6. Pastor Jim shared about learning that the common people in Israel are not supposed to touch their Rabbis (Religious teachers). How is this a positive or negative for the people they serve?
7. Compare and contrast Jesus with the typical Rabbis of His day.
8. Pastor Jim shared the story about the single mom that worked at Wendys. How did you feel as you listened to that story?
9. Would you like to be used the way that God used different people in that story?

If you don't feel God is using you in those ways right now, why do you think you are not feeling used in those powerful ways?

10. Pastor Jim shared the story about receiving the campground as a gift. His point was that God will touch those who are touching other people. Do you experience God when you are with the Body of Christ or when you are being intentional to minister to others with His Love?
11. Why are we not more compassionate toward others and more bold to share our faith in Jesus?
12. How we can we help each other “Touch” others in more powerful ways?
