

Day 7: Worship:

“Ascribe to the Lord the glory due his name; worship the Lord in the splendor of holiness.” - Psalm 29:2

Read:

Take a moment to read this verse again. Now read this:

Oh come, let us sing to the Lord;
let us make a joyful noise to the rock of our salvation!
Let us come into his presence with thanksgiving;
let us make a joyful noise to him with songs of praise!
For the Lord is a great God,
and a great King above all gods.
In his hand are the depths of the earth;
the heights of the mountains are his also.
The sea is his, for he made it,
and his hands formed the dry land.
Oh come, let us worship and bow down;
let us kneel before the Lord, our Maker!
For he is our God,
and we are the people of his pasture,
and the sheep of his hand. - **Psalm 95:1-7**

Think:

"The gathering of God's people for worship serves to shift your meditation from complaint to gratitude by reminding

you of who you really are and confronting you with the beautiful and faithful mercy of God towards you. As the Gospel puts you in your place, and as it works in your heart, it also puts praise in your mouth, and that is a very good thing.” - **Paul David Tripp**
