After some days Paul said to Barnabas, “Let us return and visit the brethren in every city in which we proclaimed the word of the Lord, *and see* how they are.”<sup>37</sup> Barnabas wanted to take **John, called Mark**, along with them also.<sup>38</sup> But Paul kept insisting that they should not take him along who had **deserted** them in Pamphylia and had not gone with them to the work. <sup>39</sup> And there occurred such a **sharp disagreement** that they **separated** from one another, and Barnabas took Mark with him and sailed away to Cyprus. <sup>40</sup> But Paul chose Silas and left, being committed by the brethren to the grace of the Lord. <sup>41</sup> And he was traveling through Syria and Cilicia, strengthening the churches.

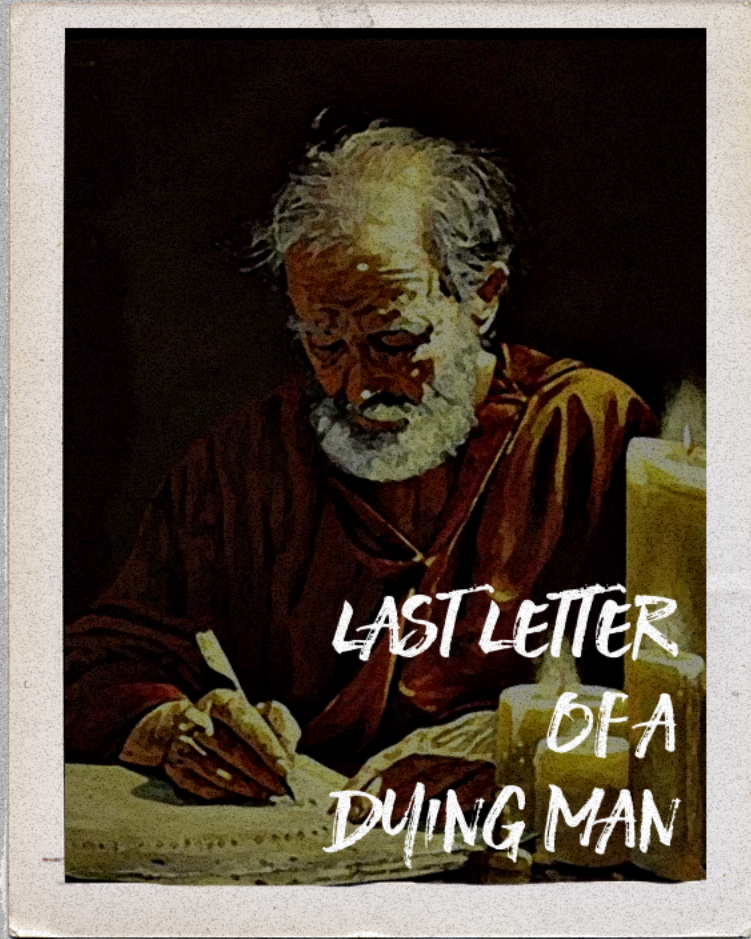
