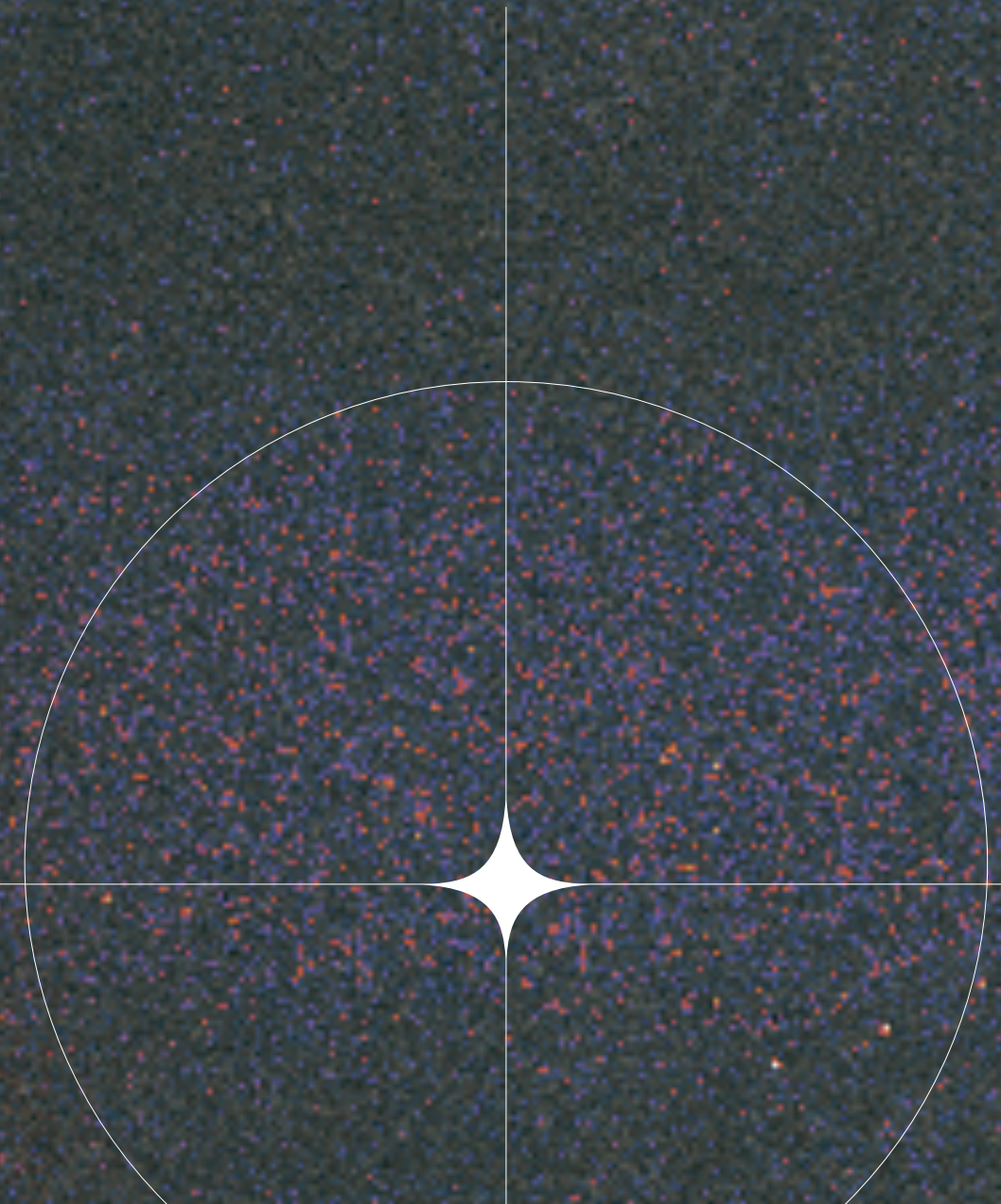

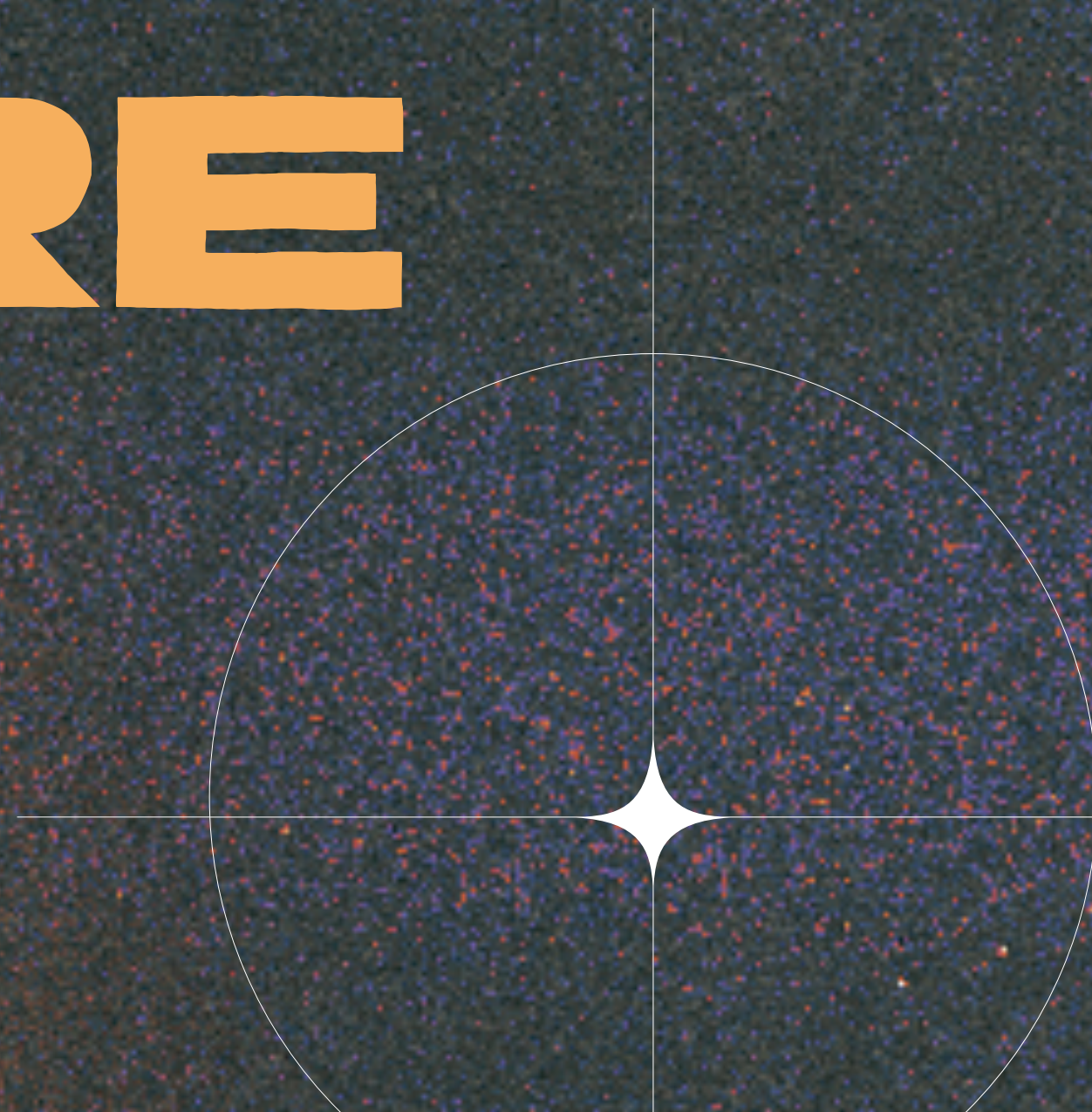

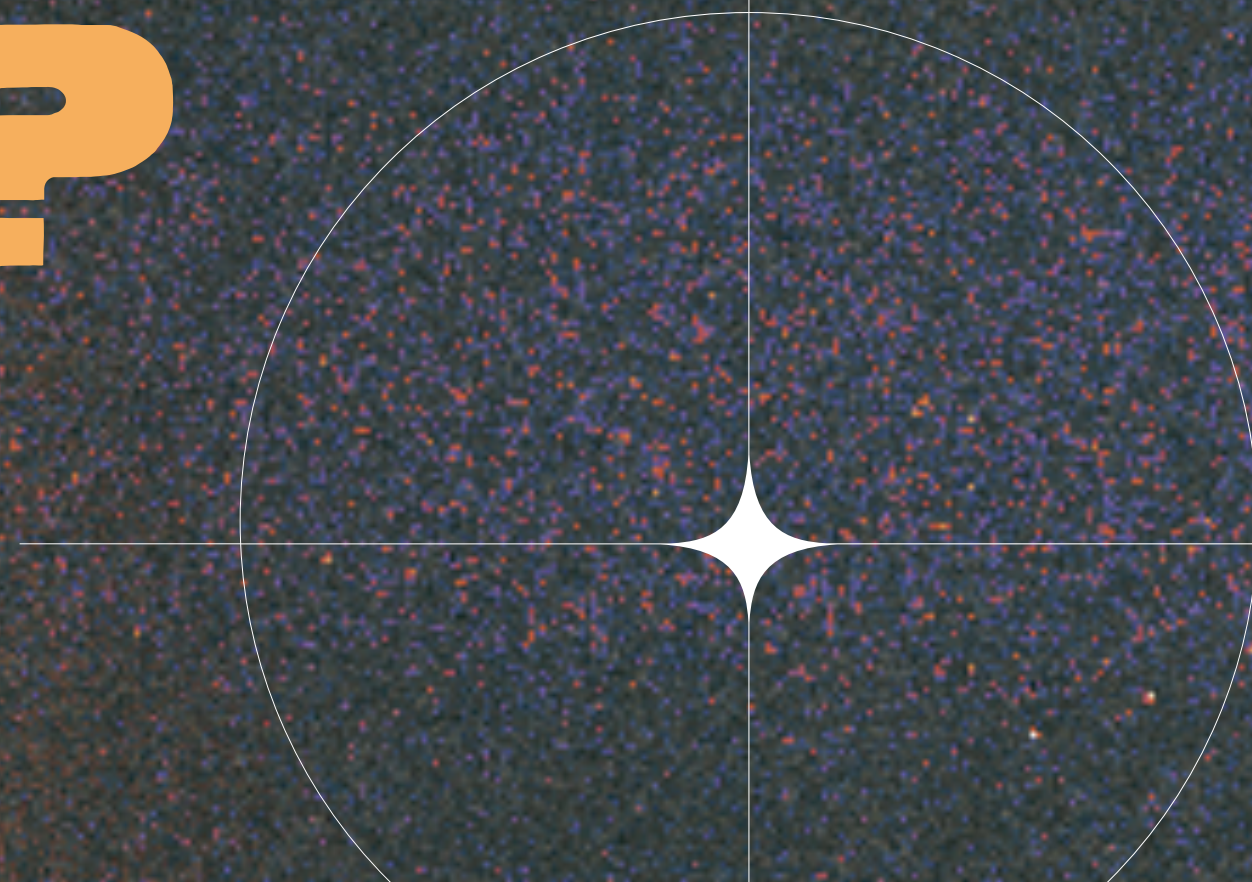
I KINGS 19:19 ESV
