Proverbs 31:25–28

A Christian home is more than a house — it is a spiritual blueprint shaped daily through love, faith, joy, teaching, and worship.

“Unless the LORD builds the house, those who build it labor in vain.” — Psalm 127:1

Six Rooms in God's Blueprint for the Christian Home

1. A Christian Home Should Be a Storm Shelter

Children need security.

Proverbs 14:26

“In the fear of the LORD one has strong confidence, and his children will have a refuge.”

A godly home should be:

- Safe
- Stable
- Grace-filled
- A place children can run to when life gets hard

Your children should know exactly where the shelter is when the storms come.

2. A Christian Home Should Be an Emergency Room

Broken hearts need healing.

Psalm 46:1 “God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble.”

Moms often become:

- Comforters
- Listeners
- Counselors
- Soul restorers

Key Thought:

Presence matters more than perfection.

3. A Christian Home Should Be a Filling Station

Kids need encouragement and fuel.

1 Samuel 1:27–28 “For this child I prayed...”

A healthy home fills children with:

- Love
- Encouragement
- Prayer
- Identity
- Truth

What are your children being filled with before they leave the house each day?

4. A Christian Home Should Be a Schoolhouse

Life lessons are taught at home.

Proverbs 6:20–23 “The teaching [of your mother is] a light...”

Moms teach:

- Integrity
- Faith
- How to treat people
- Morality
- Wisdom

Class is always in session.

5. A Christian Home Should Be a Dave & Buster’s

Joy matters.

Ecclesiastes 5:18–20 “Find enjoyment in all the toil...”

Healthy homes laugh together.

- Game nights
- Shared meals
- Traditions
- Forced family fun

Key Thought:

Some of the holiest moments in a family are the joyful ones.

6. A Christian Home Should Be a Worship Center

Faith must be lived out daily.

2 Timothy 1:5 “A sincere faith... dwelt first in your grandmother Lois and your mother Eunice...”

Children should see:

- Prayer
- Scripture
- Genuine faith
- Worship
- Trust in God

Your home is the first church your children will ever attend.
