- F. There was a struggle because in that day public decorum would be that married women would be covered to show they were married like wearing a wedding ring.
- G. This seems to be a cultural issue but Paul roots the principal in creation itself so there is something permanent for all generations
- H. Paul is making a general point but not an absolute
- I. How women are adorned in corporate worship should not cause dissension in church but should be intended to head off dissension
- J. The consistent teaching of all the Apostles on this subject always dealt with the heart of sexual decorum in worship.
