Summary:

1. *Our attitudes are shaped by what we think about most, and gospel-centered thinking transforms our perspective.*
2. *Selfish ambition and vain conceit are rooted in making life about ourselves rather than God's glory.*
3. *True humility isn't thinking less of yourself, but thinking of yourself less.*
4. *Christ's example of humble obedience—from heaven to the cross—is the ultimate model for believers.*
5. *Unity in the church comes from having the same mind and attitude as Christ.*
6. *Considering others as more significant than ourselves doesn't mean we have no value, but that we prioritize their needs.*

7. *The incarnation demonstrates God's incredible love—the Creator becoming creation to save us.*
8. *Our attitudes affect our witness, relationships, and ability to experience joy in the Christian life.*
