## **Summary**

The speaker shares a personal testimony about the power of words and positive confession, then teaches through the story of Joseph from Genesis 37. The central message is that what appears to be failure or setback in our lives may actually be God positioning us for our ultimate destiny. Using Joseph's journey from dreamer to pit to dungeon to palace, the speaker encourages believers not to lose faith during difficult seasons, as God can turn any situation around for good.

## **Top Points**

- 1. **The Power of Words**: Our confession shapes our reality saying "I'm blessed" instead of "I'm busy" can literally change our circumstances and feelings
- 2. **Dreams Create Adversaries**: When God gives you a vision, expect opposition even Joseph's own brothers hated him for his God-given dreams
- God Uses Reubens: God will always provide people or circumstances to intervene on your behalf, even when you don't realize it
- 4. **Failing Forward**: What looks like failure or defeat may actually be God moving you closer to your destiny
- 5. **Every Setback is a Setup**: Joseph went from pit to slavery to dungeon to palace each "failure" positioned him for greater purpose
- 6. **Don't Quit During the Process**: Perseverance through difficulty is essential because you may be one step away from breakthrough
- 7. **Your Mess Becomes Your Message**: God can use your past struggles to help others and give you an anointing for ministry
