Summary

Pastor Willy Contreras delivers a message about maintaining an attitude of gratitude and remembering God's goodness in all circumstances. Drawing from personal experiences at a football game and missionary work in Mexico, he emphasizes that God's goodness has been, is, and will continue to be present in believers' lives. He challenges the congregation to stay connected to God's goodness by dwelling in His house, sharing testimonies of His faithfulness, and returning to childlike faith.

Top Points Made

1. **Attitude of Gratitude Opens Doors** - Maintaining a grateful attitude, even in difficult circumstances, positions us for God's blessings and opens opportunities in life.
2. **God's Goodness is Constant** - God's goodness isn't limited to moments or seasons; it has been, is now, and will continue to be present in our lives.
3. **Stay in His Goodness** - Leaving the house of God (spiritually stepping away from His presence and community) means leaving His goodness, which leads to spiritual decline.
4. **God Forgives All and Heals All** - God's goodness includes complete forgiveness of sins and healing of all sickness, not just some.
5. **Don't Wait for Crisis** - We shouldn't only seek God when we need a miracle; we need to be with Him all the time to experience His continual goodness.
6. **Share His Goodness** - Believers are called to declare and spread God's goodness to others through testimony and action.
7. **Return to Childlike Faith** - We must shut down fear and return to simple, trusting, childlike faith in our good Father.
8. **Goodness and Mercy Follow Us** - These aren't occasional visitors but constant companions

throughout our lives when we walk with God.

2. "If you maintain that attitude, doors open. Good things are going to happen to you because God works in the goodness, Church."
