Summary

Guest Speaker Phillip Baker delivers a powerful message about overcoming the cycles of spiritual defeat ("two steps forward, one step back") by learning to handle pressure the way Jesus did. Speaking at World Harvest Church, he emphasizes that while Satan creates infinite layers of pressure in our lives, we have the choice whether to "crack" under that pressure. The sermon focuses on three ways people crack (saying things they can't take back, doing things they regret, and neglecting things they can't afford to neglect) and introduces Jesus's approach to handling pressure, beginning with running to His secret place of prayer.

God's 2025 Word to Evangelist Phillip Baker: "**Nothing But Forward**" - The theme for the year is moving forward without taking steps backward spiritually, physically, or financially.

Satan's Primary Weapon: Pressure - Satan has created a world with infinite layers of pressure that affects everyone from young to old, targeting finances, relationships, health, and expectations.

Three Ways People "Crack" Under Pressure:

- Say things they can't take back
- Do things they regret
- Neglect things they can't afford to neglect (prayer, Bible study, church attendance, tithing, serving)

The Altar is Sacred - Religion has stolen the altar, but it's a place where God pours out special grace and where the church family should gather in faith.

Men Must Lead the Way - Strong men create strong marriages, which create strong families, churches, and ultimately a strong kingdom.

Jesus's Response to Pressure - Even under the ultimate pressure before His crucifixion, Jesus didn't crack, and neither do believers have to crack.

The Secret Place is Essential - Like Jesus who ran to the Garden of Gethsemane, believers need a secret place of prayer that becomes more important during pressured seasons.
