## Summary

Join Pastor Jaime as he delivers an end-of-year message focusing on intentional daily living through five key declarations he prays each morning. Using personal testimonies including his brother's healing from leukemia and a recent miraculous incident with a student, he challenges the congregation to move beyond routine Christianity to actively walk in love, faith, and wisdom while pointing others to Jesus and expecting divine appointments (Kairos moments). He emphasizes the importance of "numbering our days" and making each 24-hour period count for eternity rather than just going through the motions of life.

## Top Points Made

1. **Victory Mentality:** The church should praise FROM victory, not FOR victory - moving from a defensive position to an offensive one in faith
2. **Gratitude Practice:** Never stop giving God credit and glory for victories, both big and small, as gratitude attracts more blessings
3. **Time Management Like Financial Budgeting:** Just as budgeting money requires intentional management, we must "number our days" and manage our 24 hours with the same wisdom and intentionality
4. **The Five Daily Declarations:**
  - Walk in agape love (experience and express God's love)
  - Walk by faith (speak to mountains, walk on water, raise the dead)
  - Walk in wisdom (apply knowledge, not just possess it)

- Lead people to Christ and point them to Jesus
  - Believe for Kairos moments (divine appointments and breakthrough opportunities)
5. **Faith Over Feelings:** When symptoms or challenges arise, respond first with faith and the Word rather than natural remedies or fear
  6. **Ministry Updates:** The church is navigating decisions about facility expansion and potentially relocating Harvest Christian Academy's high school to accommodate growth and serve more students
  7. **Prophetic Living:** Speaking by faith what you desire to have, not just accepting circumstances as they appear
  8. **Every Day Matters:** Don't live just to reach retirement; make each day count for eternity and enjoy the present moments
  9. **Opportunities in Disguise:** Kairos moments often don't come with fanfare - keep your eyes up and stay alert to divine opportunities
  10. **Christ as Wisdom:** True wisdom produces fruit and comes from Christ who has been made wisdom unto us, not just from human knowledge or credentials
