## Summary

Join Pastor Jaime this Mother's Day as he delivers a heartfelt message celebrating the unique, God-ordained role of motherhood. Drawing from Luke 1 and Deuteronomy 6, he emphasized that every child is a "one of one" — a divine assignment given specifically to their mother. Using the vivid image of a brooding hen protecting her chicks, he illustrated how a mother's nurturing creates the emotional and spiritual foundation a child needs to thrive. He shared personal stories — from his own mother's influence during seasons of loss, to witnessing a young boy's tears disappear the moment his mom kissed his hand — to show how irreplaceable a mother's love truly is. Co-speaker Steph encouraged moms to extend themselves grace, reminding them that faith is more often caught than taught, and that simply living a life of love before their children is the most powerful form of discipleship.

## Top Points

1. Every child is a "one of one." Just as God sent a specific child through Mary, every mother has been uniquely graced to birth and raise the specific child God gave her — no one else could have brought that child into the world.
2. Mothers are divinely graced nurturers. Like a hen that transforms from skittish to fearless the moment she is brooding, motherhood activates a God-given protective and nurturing instinct unlike any other.
3. Early nurturing literally wires a child's soul. Referencing an adoption class, Pastor Jaime explained that every time a mother responds to an infant's cry, she is building neural and emotional pathways — creating a child who knows they are safe, loved, and worthy of care.
4. A mother's belief shapes a son's identity. Boys are wired to dream of greatness, and a mother's consistent affirmation is the fuel that keeps that dream alive — even into adulthood.
5. Faith is caught, not just taught. Steph reminded mothers that how they *live* — their worship, their grace under pressure, their love for God — is the most lasting lesson they will ever pass on to their children.
6. You are a safe place. A mother's presence provides shelter, warmth, and healing that no title, award, or achievement can replace or replicate.
7. Motherhood is the most important assignment on earth. Pastor Jaime stated plainly that no career, title, or platform outranks the sacred call of being a mother — and he refused to walk that back.
