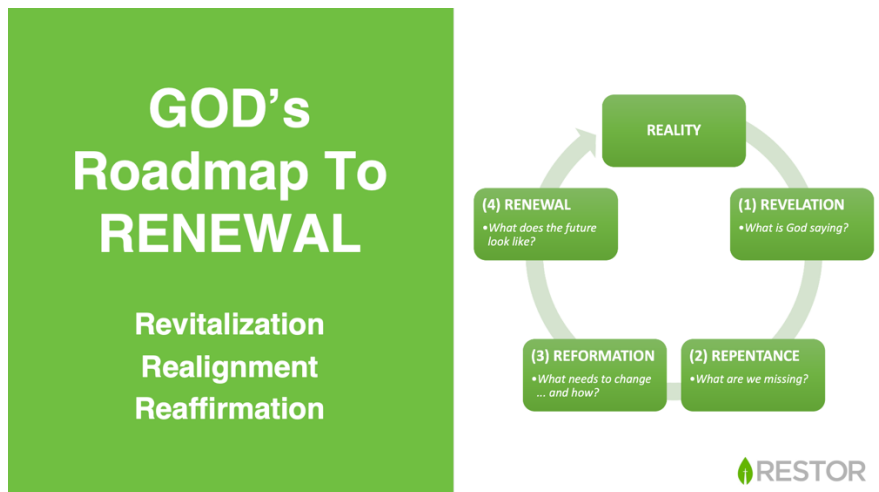

### **Discuss:**

1. Read 2 Cor. 4:7-18 and discuss. “Why” (\*hint) did Pastor Patrick begin in this text on Vision Sunday?
2. What stands out to you in the text (above)? Do you have a good “but not?” If not, why not? If so, what is it?
3. Pastor Patrick spent time reviews the RESTOR Renewal Process that we’ve been in as a church these past several months. Look at the “Roadmap to Renewal” slide above and discuss.
4. Though we’ve been going through this process as a church, how might this “roadmap” serve you personally? Which part of the process seems the most difficult to you personally?
5. Look at the “VLC Core Values” and mission statement (above) and discuss. What stands out to you? What excites you the most?
6. The Pastors shares several initiatives for 2022: Increased Connection Opportunities, Personal Discipleship Plan, Expanding Leadership, Increasing Leadership Health (Tin Man Ministries), Mission Catalyst Team, Project Housewarming 3, Hiring. Which one are you most excited about?
7. A video was shared on Sunday of several Valley Lifers sharing their thoughts about our church. As a group, take a moment and respond yourselves. The questions asked were:

- a. What makes VLC feel like home to you?
- b. What has involvement at VLC meant to you personally?
- c. How would you describe VLC in one sentence?

8. What questions do you still have following Vision Sunday?
