Consult the Scriptures:

Acts 2:1-41

(Other Scripture referenced: Heb. 10:24-25, 11:1, Acts 1:1-8, 4:12, Jn. 14:17, 16:7, 1 Cor. 6:19, Gen. 12:3, Lk. 10:2)

Discuss:

1. Pastor Patrick opened by talking about a tree that went down in his yard recently during a storm. He compared the downed tree to the effects of last three months on our lives. How are you doing? Metaphorically, is there debris in your yard? Is a tree down? Any structure damage? Share with one another how you're doing and what you're feeling.
2. What was it like for you this weekend to be gathered "together in one place" (Acts 2:1)? For those with health concerns still meeting online, how did Sunday affect your longing to be with God's people even while it may have been wise that you to continue online?
3. Read Acts 2:1-41 and discuss. What struck you about the sermon this week? What about this passage stirred you?

4. Do you find yourself asking either of the two questions being asked in Acts 2? (1) "What does this mean?" or (2) "What shall we do?" With each question what is the need?
5. How will you respond to the text this week?
