Consult the Scriptures:

Genesis 24:1-67 Romans 8:30 Philippians 1:6

(Other Scripture referenced: Gen. 12:1-3; 22:17; Job 42:2-6; Eph. 1:11-14)

Discuss:

- 1. Take some time to discuss the question Pastor Patrick posed on Sunday: Is it possible for God to take a risk? Why or why not?
- 2. Related to the above: Is it possible for the purposes of God to fail? Why or why not?
- 3. Read Romans 8:30 and discuss. This passage has been referred to as "the golden chain of salvation." What does that mean?
- 4. What does that mean (related to the above) regarding our part in the purposes of God? Are we superfluous? Why or why not?

- 5. Read Genesis 24:1-67 and discuss. What stands out to you in this story? What do we learn about God? What do we learn about ourselves? And what do we learn about the plans/purposes of God (i.e. the story of God)?
- 6. What immediate applications can be made in light of this text?
- 7. What question do you still have?
