CONSULT THE SCRIPTURES

Malachi 4:1-6 Mark 1:1-9a

(Other texts cited: Is. 9:2-6, Mal. 3:1, 2 Kings 1:8, Mk. 9:11-13, Mt. 11:11-15)

DISCUSS

- 1. Pastor Patrick talked about a concept known as "the dynamic of visual lethargy." Explain. What does it mean? As a group share some examples from your own life.
- 2. How does "the dynamic of visual lethargy" endanger us spiritually? Have you experienced this in your life or are you experiencing this now?
- 3. Pastor Patrick defined "excitement" as "strong feelings of enthusiasm and eagerness." He said "to excite is to call to activity; to rouse an emotional response; to awaken. Read Malachi 4:1-6 and discuss. Does this passage fit our definition of "excitement?"

4. How do you feel when you read Malachi 4:5, "The great and awesome day of the Lord?"
5. Pastor Patrick argued that Mark saw both the coming of John the Baptist and the coming of Christ as a fulfillment of Malachi 4. Read Mark 1:1-9a and discuss. ²
6. What immediate applications can be made in light of this text? How can we together fight "the dynamic of visual lethargy" this Christmas?
