Roman 8:15-17a

- Before Christ, our sin that we inherited from Adam and Eve made us **offensive** to God, and there was **nothing** we could do about it.
- However, when we accept Christ as our Savior, everything changes as we pass from spiritual **death** to **life**...
2 Corinthians 5:17, Matthew 7:20
- The moment we were **born again**, we inherited a whole **new** core identity.
John 15:1-5, Colossians 2:6-7, 1 Corinthians 1:2
- If you have received Jesus as your Lord and Savior, you are not just a forgiven **sinner** but a redeemed **saint**!
John 1:12
- In order for us to **grow** and **mature** in this new life, we must believe that we really are children of God.
Romans 6:23a, Romans 6:23b, 1 John 2:1, 1 John 1:8

Q: What's the appropriate thing to do, when we do something that we know is wrong or displeasing to God and we're ashamed of our actions?

- We must simply go to God and **agree** with Him that we were wrong (confess our sin); then we must **turn away** from our sin (repentance).
