- 1. ICEBREAKER: What trivial thing do you complain about? (Leader Tip: Think silly thing slike traffic, picking the wrong line at the grocery store, etc.)
- 2. How is lament different from complaining? In what ways is it actually an act
- 3. What were the three characteristics of lament?
 - a. Complain to God
 - b. Beg God for help
 - c. Decide to trust God
- 4. Which of these 3 do you see the *most* evidence of in your life right now? What does that practically look like?
- 5. Which of these 3 do you need to take a step of growth in right now? What might that first step *practically* look like?
- 6. When life gets hard, who's the first person in your life you turn to? Why that person? Leader Tip: This isn't a trap. The answer doesn't have to be "Jesus." We want to start a conversation on what makes us approachable in seasons of trouble and how God is the ultimate
- 7. This next question requires some trust from one another, but it's worth it: what are you currently needing to lament over? How can we pray for that with one another?

PRAY: Pray for the answers/situations given in question #7 - be SURE and set a reminder to pray during the week and message one another how you're praying for one another before your group meets again.
