

## Small Group Questions "Baggage" | 1 Samuel 13:8-14, Luke 19:32-40, 41-44 Week 3: Discontentment | April 10, 2022

- 1. ICEBREAKER: What's something you *hate* waiting for? (Line at the grocery store, light to turn green, DMV, etc.)
  - a. Why is waiting in general so difficult for us?
- 2. How does Saul's decision to take matters in his own hands make sense to you?
  - a. Can you think of times when common sense stands opposed to obeying God?
- 3. Share about a time when you struggled to wait on God? What did you learn? How did you handle the situation?
- 4. Steven claimed that "choosing to wait on God is contagious." Do you agree or disagree? Why? Can you share about a time when you've experienced this?
  - a. What should the role of community be when we're struggling to wait on God?
- 5. What would it *practically* (daily, weekly, etc.) look like to live out the words of Jesus in Matthew 6:33 when we're struggling to wait on God?
- 6. Steven shared that discontentment can lead us into:
  - a. Indulgence, then
  - b. Lack
  - c. an inability to experience something the way God designed us to
  - d. When/how have you seen this in your life or others?
