Week 3: Discontentment | April 10, 2022

1. ICEBREAKER: What’s something you *hate* waiting for? (Line at the grocery store, light to turn green, DMV, etc.)
 - a. Why is waiting in general so difficult for us?
2. How does Saul’s decision to take matters in his own hands make sense to you?
 - a. Can you think of times when common sense stands opposed to obeying God?
3. Share about a time when you struggled to wait on God? What did you learn? How did you handle the situation?
4. Steven claimed that “choosing to wait on God is contagious.” Do you agree or disagree? Why? Can you share about a time when you’ve experienced this?
 - a. What should the role of community be when we’re struggling to wait on God?
5. What would it *practically* (daily, weekly, etc.) look like to live out the words of Jesus in Matthew 6:33 when we’re struggling to wait on God?
6. Steven shared that discontentment can lead us into:
 - a. Indulgence, then
 - b. Lack
 - c. an inability to experience something the way God designed us to
 - d. When/how have you seen this in your life or others?
