- 5. When you talk to unmarried friends about seeking a spouse, how could the book of Ruth inform what you say?
 - a. What wisdom is there from the book of Ruth for married couples on how to build a thriving marriage?
- 6. When and how have you seen God's persistent and particular providence on display in your life?
- 7. What is one thing God has taught you so far through the Ruth series? Who is someone you could encourage with what you're learning?
