### “Ruth: Ruin to Redemption” | Ruth 4:1-6, 13-22, Matthew 1, 2:6 Week 5: March 13, 2022

  - a. What price might the Lord be calling you to pay for the good of others?
4. Take a closer look at Matthew's genealogy of Jesus in Matthew 1? How might this help you if you were talking with a friend who doesn't feel good enough to follow Jesus?
5. When you talk to unmarried friends about seeking a spouse, how could the book of Ruth inform what you say?
  - a. What wisdom is there from the book of Ruth for married couples on how to build a thriving marriage?
6. When and how have you seen God's persistent and particular providence on display in your life?
7. What is one thing God has taught you so far through the Ruth series? Who is someone you could encourage with what you're learning?
