

Life Group Questions "Greatest:" Loving God | August 27, 2023 Week 1: Mark 12:28-34, Luke 10:38-42, Deut. 6:4-9 | Stuart Chapman

- 1. ICEBREAKER: Begin your group the same way Stu began our service. Ask a few "Who's the greatest _____?" questions or "What's the greatest _____?" Then ask for the rest of the group to raise hands to agree/disagree and feel free to friendly debate as much as possible. ©
- 2. What's one thing that stuck out to you from Stu's sermon? What did God teach you?
- 3. From Mark 12, Jesus is asked what's the *greatest* commandment, and he responds with *two* greatest commandments. Stu correctly said the two commandments are "distinct but inseparable."
 - a. Do you agree? Why or why not?
 - b. If you were asked to explain a bit further how these two go together, what might you say?
- 4. From Luke 10, when have you had a Mary like season in your life, content to just be with Jesus?
- 5. From Luke 10, when have you had a Martha like season in your life, busy with doing things *for* Jesus, which is good but not the *greatest* good?
 - a. How do we balance between the two in our daily lives? What are some practical best practices for keeping this balance?
- 6. From Deuteronomy 6, how would you answer someone who is curious about *how to apply* the greatest commandment Jesus quotes in Mark 12?
- 7. Are the Deuteronomy 6 commandments to pass down the faith to the next generation *exclusive* to parents? Why or why not? As adult members of Faith Church, how can *every adult* be involved in passing down faith to the next generation?
- 8. ***PRAY together*** Spend some time praying for this new fall season as students (and parents!) go back to school.
