Joshua: “Strong and Courageous”
Week 2: Joshua 2:1-24 | June 11, 2023

1. Last week we were invited to begin each day with a simple declaration based on Joshua 1:9, “The promise-keeping God is always with me so I will be strong and courageous.”
 - a. How did this go? How consistent were you? Did you notice anything about how your week was different?
 - b. If you didn’t do this (totally fine! Invitation, not expectation), what part of the declaration is most encouraging to you?
2. How should God’s forgiveness of us affect how we forgive others?
3. What can we learn about God’s character and plan when we see him saving and using people like Rahab?
4. From Deuteronomy 9:6, we saw God has always been gracious to stubborn people. How have you seen this true in your own life?
5. Which of the three parts of this week’s bottom line is most encouraging to you? Reminder: Jesus saves unlikely sinners (1) who he transforms into unlikely servants (2) as he keeps his promise to build his diverse church (3). Which one do you need a fresh reminder of this week?
6. *This question is a repeat from Week 1 but if your group didn’t meet last week, use this for week 2!* In what areas of life do you feel you need to grow in what it means to be strong and courageous? What should that practically look like?
